Marin County is expansive and once here, we want to help you. Below are a handful of traffic tips that will help you on the roads. There is also a variety of transportation methods of getting around, from bus and ferry service, to destination shuttles and airport transfers.

#### **LOCATION**

Marin County is located in Northern California, just across the Golden Gate Bridge, north of San Francisco and nestled between Sonoma County to the north, and Napa County to the north-east. The main north-south artery, Highway 101, allows access to San Francisco and Sonoma Counties, while Highway One provides access to the communities of West Marin/Point Reyes Seashore and our scenic Marin coast.

#### **CLIMATE**

Marin enjoys a temperate, Mediterranean climate year round. Winters are moderate with temperatures averaging 55 degrees Fahrenheit, with the possibility of rain. Summers are warm and dry, with the strong possibility of morning and evening fog, especially in the Golden Gate area. The average summer temperature is 82 degrees Fahrenheit. A light coat or jacket is recommended for the summer evenings.

#### Let us help plan your visit

Start the day with a tour of legendary Muir Woods National Monument, a remnant of the ancient coastal redwood forests that blanketed many Northern California coastal valleys before the 1800s. From there, travel north on coastal Highway 1 and visit the Point Reyes National Seashore. In the quaint town of Point Reyes Station, tour a creamery and observe cheese making in action as the creamery makes 3,000 pounds of handmade cheese each week.

Marin County is also the birthplace of mountain biking. Bike famous Mt. Tamalpais and have your breath taken away both by the stunning ocean views and steep climbs through tall trees and mountain air.
